Sports Premium Statement 2018-2019

Background

The funding is being jointly provided by the Departments for Education, Health and Culture, Media and Sport, and will see money going directly to primary schools to spend on improving the quality of sport and PE for all their children. The purpose of the funding is that schools will have to spend the sport funding in improving their provision of PE but they will have the freedom to choose how they do this.

Allocation

Each school will receive **£16,000** plus an **extra £10** per pupil each year for the next two years - here at Gorsmoor Primary School that means around **£21,000** a year. The money can **only** be spent on sport and PE provision in schools.

Accountability

Schools will be held to account for how they spend the Sport Funding. Ofsted has strengthened its coverage of sport and PE within the Inspectors' Handbook and supporting guidance, so that schools and inspectors know how sport and PE will be assessed in future as part of the schools' overall provision offered. The Leadership Team and Physical Education Co-ordinator at Gorsmoor Primary School will regularly monitor and assess the impact of this funding.
