We learn through dance, song and spoken language.

Alongside learning the Spanish language, we learn about the culture of Spain including their music, traditions, festivals, religion and cuisine.

We learn about the geography of Spain; where Spain is located within our world; the weather; climate and physical features.

Around our school, we are beginning to embed the Spanish language by showcasing the Spanish translation underneath many of our important phrases and signs.

In Phase 3, some of our children have the roles of 'Spanish Ambassadors' where they have responsibilities, alongside the subject leader to monitor learning and create exciting enrichment opportunities. They offer a valued contribution to our teachings of Spanish.
