

All children eligible for PPG attended a school trip last year.

5 out of 7 children eligible for PPG achieved the expected standard in Reading and Maths at the end of Key Stage One.

All eligible PPG children in Year 6 attended Easter booster clubs to ease anxiety towards their SATs.

A dedicated Pupil Premium supported identified groups and individuals across the curriculum from Year 1 to Year 5.

Children eligible for PPG attended cookery sessions as part of our nurture support in Y6.

Dedicated Pupil Premium teacher supported eligible children in Year 6 lessons and nurture groups.

All lunchtime supervisors received training to support pupil behaviour.

5 out of 7 children eligible for PPG passed the Year 1 Phonics check.



Raised awareness of Pupil Premium Grant within school to ensure that all eligible families are accessing the grant and support.

As part of our nurture support, pupils attended gardening club.

Teaching Assistants formed an Inclusion team to support identified pupils, in small groups and 1:1.

Pastoral Support Worker has supported numerous PPG children across the school; developing their confidence and resilience, as well as helping to build relationships.

13/14 pupils who sat the KS2 Maths SAT achieved the expected standard. 1 pupil who did not achieve the standard has a standardised score of 98**.

All PPG eligible children were reviewed as part of our termly pupil progress and data meetings.

PPG eligible families had access to support with uniform costs.

All children eligible for Pupil Premium Grant in Year 5 attended a week residential to Laches Wood.
